Pacific Carbon Trust (PCT) is a Crown corporation of the Government of BC, created to deliver quality made-in-BC greenhouse gas offsets to help clients reduce their carbon footprint and drive the growth of BC's low-carbon economy. Pacific Carbon Trust has signed its first agreement to purchase high quality offsets to address climate change. It provides the ability to offset 330,000 tonnes of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions over five years starting in June 2009. The offsets are generated through 15 projects located in B.C. Join us to hear David Moffat talk about the business of PCT--what is a carbon offset, PCT's buying operations (standards and clients) and selling offsets (business opportunities, process and requirements). He will also talk about their plans to offer a forestry carbon offset opportunity.

Speaker

David Moffat is Managing Director, Business Development at Pacific Carbon Trust, responsible for offset supply development, client relations and marketing. David brings extensive experience in business development from his work at Clark Sustainable Resource Developments, where he was responsible for strategic marketing and sustainability, and at DEKA R&D Corporation, where he led business development for clean power and water purification technologies. Earlier, he structured and negotiated conservation real estate transactions for The Nature Conservancy, directed development projects for the World Bank and founded an NGO in Africa. David received an MBA from Harvard Business School and a Masters of Environmental Management from Yale University's School of Forestry and Environmental Studies. In his increasingly rare spare time, David gets up too early in the morning to go rowing.
